

 What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.




22. Are the library staffs cooperative? 251 responses



Introduction:

The feedback survey conducted for the academic year 2019-20 at Maharani Kasiswari College has provided insights into the areas where students suggests improvements. This report outlines the key areas of concern as identified by the students and summarises the action taken to address these issues.

Key Feedback Points

1. Improvement of Soft Skill

Feedback summary: Students expressed the need for improvement of soft skill for their value-addition.

Comments: Many students emphasized the importance of developing soft skills like communication skills, leadership training, group-activities etc.

2. More Toilet Facilities

Feedback Summary: There was a significant demand for an increase in the number of toilet facilities to accommodate the student population adequately.
