Dr Dalia Ghosh Dastidar is a Fulbright Doctoral Fellow with a Ph.D. in population dynamics of free-ranging venomous snakes. She has worked on the ecology of diverse vertebrate taxa in human-altered and protected ecosystems. She has always been intrigued by human cohabitation with surrounding biodiversity, including conflict species.

She mainly discussed on the topic entitled as “Community perspectives in environmental sustainability”. She focused on the Global Hunger Index, fertilizer consumption, diversity and nutrition of food, importance of healthy food chain, sustainable life style change etc during her lecture session. She also emphasized on the role of indigenous Irula snake-catcher community. Her speech was very motivating and encouraging to all the participants.

After the lecture session, questions and interaction session was conducted by Smt. Shreya Ghosh, faculty of the Department of Environmental Studies.

Environmental documentary film on “the Story of Adi Ganga” documented by “the Anandabazar Online”, was nicely presented by Mr. Amit Choudhury, faculty of the Department of Computer Science” through YouTube channel.
