PROGRAMME OUTCOME HISTORY (HONOURS) UNDER CBCS

- Upon completing their studies, students in the Honors course of the History Department will have a comprehensive understanding of the history of Europe across various stages and periods.
- The course provides valuable assistance to students by allowing them to select a subject for specialization in their Master's Degree, thanks to the comprehensive understanding they get of the subject. Typically, undergraduate students choose the specific period of history that they have a preference for or appreciate.
- If students have an affinity for Museology, they have the option to pursue it as a career in the future by working at Museums and Archives. This is because students have already acquired knowledge about Museums and Archives through the SEC (Skill Enhancement Course).
- Their understanding of the culture and heritage of India is much expanded, and their interest in the traditions of India is also heightened.
- Additionally, individuals have the opportunity to pursue a post-graduate degree in Archaeology and thereafter seek employment with the Archaeological Survey of India or various universities.
- Individuals have the opportunity to participate in examinations conducted by the School Service Commission and College Service Commission. Upon obtaining a PhD degree, individuals are eligible to seek for positions at universities and colleges.
- They can also participate in numerous competitive examinations such as IAS, WBCS, and other administrative positions. In addition, they have the opportunity to pursue a legal education and qualify for positions in the field of law.

HISTORY (GENERAL) UNDER CBCS

- Upon graduation, students specializing in History will gain a comprehensive understanding of both the History of India and the History of the World.
- History is a subject that is included in different competitive examinations such as SSC, TET, and Civil Service (IAS and WBCS), where candidates are required to take exams on this subject.
- During additional interviews, students are frequently questioned about topics pertaining to the History of India and the World. An individual with a comprehensive understanding of History, who has studied the topic as part of their academic programme, will be capable of providing accurate and thorough responses to these questions.
- Additionally, they will possess the capability to respond to the general knowledge inquiries on the exam, as a significant portion of it pertains to History.
- The Skill Enhancement Course provides individuals with knowledge and understanding of Museums and Archives, as well as Historical Tourism, which they might pursue as a profession.
- Their understanding of the culture and heritage of India is significantly expanded, and their interest in the traditions of India is also heightened.
