Details of experiential learning through Internship/on the job training:

Session 2020-2021:

<u>Objective</u>: The tourism industry needs qualified managerial personnel to maintain facilities and services to the tourists of international standards. It is felt that, the internship programme will be of immense importance in getting trained students with practical knowledge in the field of tourism industry. In this view industry-institute interface is the primary need to fulfill the requirements of manpower development.

No of students participated: 37

Duration of the training: Training could not arrange due to Corona Pandemic.

Internship/ On the Job Training Report-Tourism industry which is emerging as the second largest industry in the world; the govt. must to take professional view to go ahead. Govt. has decided to have the trained manpower in the industry. In Maharani Kasiswari College under the University of Calcutta Tourism and Travel management course has been introduced in the 1999-2000 session. As per existing guidelines by the University in CBCS system, Semester-V DSE-B (1) paper consists of Internship programme. All students have to be submitted **Internship/On the job training report**, which is to be held every year in the final year (Fifth Semester) with the assistance by the Dept. of Tourism, Govt. of West Bengal. The Department of Tourism Govt. of West Bengal provides assistance on the job training with their official guidance. Students visit Department of Tourism Govt. of West Bengal during their training programme. They collect different information about different tourist places in West Bengal on their training period and visit Hotel/Lodge to collect different information about the Hotel. The tourism department also organizes a city tour in Kolkata and the students collect different information about various places surrounded by the Kolkata city. Before appearing the fifth semester exam, every student should submit a project report showing details about during their training and mention the activities perform by the Department of Tourism Govt. of West Bengal for promotion of tourism in the state.

However, due to pandemic situation in 2021, we were unable to organize on the job-training programme. Students submitted a project report in online mode. The department conducted project evaluation in online mode according to their project report submission.
