Dear Dr. Chakrabarty:

The Agri-food Policy Platform of the International Rice Research Institute is currently implementing a research study which aims to understand the drivers of food choice in eastern India using the *gastronomic systems research* (GSR) framework and to identify entry points for nutrition-sensitive interventions that are context- and culture-specific. We are in the last phase of the study wherein we are developing a food choice application that will be used in the behavioral experiment to test consumers' response to nutrition-sensitive interventions. The main objective of this behavioral experiment is to elicit consumers' "ideal" meal portfolio for their household given a certain budget. The app will show a list of dishes for each eating occasion (i.e., breakfast, AM snacks, lunch, PM snacks, and dinner). These dishes were generated from the expert elicitation workshop with food experts, FGDs with consumers, and a large-scale survey conducted last year. Dr. Anindita Ray (Chakravarti) is one of our resource persons who participated in the expert elicitation workshop.

In line with this, we are once again inviting Dr. Anindita Ray (Chakravarti) to collaborate with IRRI in the food app development and implementation of the behavioral experiment. In the food app development, one of the activities includes cooking activity. This exercise aims to standardize dish ingredients, serving portions, cost, and cooking of dishes. Along with this invitation, we would like to seek for your permission to engage your students, under the supervision of Dr. Anindita Ray (Chakravarti), and to utilize the University's food lab to conduct the aforementioned cooking activity. The students' involvement aims to expose them in the field of behavioral experiment. We will work with Dr. Anindita Ray (Chakravarti) in the development of the food lab protocol to serve as guide in the cooking activity. All the costs related to the lab including ingredients of the food cost will be covered by IRRI.

We aim to start the cooking activity on third week of August. The actual behavioral experiments are scheduled on the second week of November. Should you have inquiries or concerns, you may contact Dr. Arindam Samaddar (a.samaddar@irri.org).
