### MARCH THROUGH SEARCH

The origin of Maharani Kasiswari College may be linked to the great love for education and learning of the Cosimbazar Royal Family of Murshidabad, West Bengal, India. Starting from Krishna Kanta Nandy great-grandson of Kalsath Nandy (founder of Cosimbazar Estate) to Raja Harinath (greatson of Kanta Babu) Raja Krishnath (son of Harinath), Maharani Swaminarayee (wife of Raja Krishnath), Maharaj Manindra Chandra Nandy (brother of Maharani Swaminarayee), Maharaja Sri Chandra Nandy (son of Manindra Chandra Nandy) - all spent majority of their wealth towards the cause of education throughout Bengal. Establishment of Hindu College, Krishnath College of Barhampore, Lady Dufferin Medical Hostel of Kolkata and several other schools and colleges are few examples of their immense patronage for promotion of education in Bengal.


This college building at 20, Ramkanta Bose Street, Shyambazar, Kolkata, India was an ancestral property of Maharaj Manindra Nandy. In this house, he was born on 28th May 1890 and was married to Maharani Kasiswari of Burdwan, West Bengal, India when he was seventeen and the bride was only seven. After passing away of Manindra Chandra, Maharaj Sri Chandra, donated their house for setting up of a College in that premises. On 15th July, 1941 Maharaj Manindra Chandra College was established.

From 1st October, 1947 a morning section of the College was opened to meet the aspirations of the neighbourhood girls for education. This morning section, meant exclusively for girl students, started functioning from 2nd December, 1964 and was named as Maharani Kasiswari College, to perpetuate the memory of Maharani Kasiswari, who once entered this house as a seven year old bride. Since its inception, the college believes in the thought that 'education empowers women'.

At present the college has approximately 2500 students. The college is affiliated to University of Calcutta and accredited by National Assessment & Accreditation Council, India. It is an under-graduate college providing teaching in streams of Arts, Science, Commerce and Mass Media.
