REPORT ON NSS SPECIAL CAMP 2024

<u>DAY 5:</u>

Exciting events were planned on the 5th day of the NSS for the students of Narkeldanga Girls' High School at Phoolbangan. The NSS volunteers along with the Department of Environmental Science were in charge of the events in the first half of the day. A short clip regarding the growing dependence of plastic implements and therefore plastic pollution was shown to the students. The students were quizzed on the clip that was shown. Another clip regarding which plastics could be reused and which were single use plastics and how to identify them was also shown. The students were encouraged to restrict the use of single use plastic bags in their daily lives. As an alternative, they were taught how to make strong bags with Newspapers. All the students made bags with the teacher and distributed them at home and in their community. They were to encourage their elders to switch to environment friendly bags instead of plastic bags. The students thoroughly enjoyed this hands-on experience and were surprised at how easy it was to make the bags and took great pride in their creations.

After a short break where sumptuous Tiffin was provided to the students, the afternoon session commenced under the guidance of the department of Geography and NSS volunteers. An informative PPT was shown regarding the Earth's crust and the formation of various types of rocks. Various types of rocks were distributed amongst the students and their characteristics were explained to the students. The students were encouraged to feel the various rocks to discern their layers, hardness, gradient etc. A movie regarding Earth's formation, the evolution of Man and the various landforms were shown to the students. Since this enriched and supplemented their studies, the students thoroughly enjoyed this experience.

<u>DAY 6:</u>

The department of Psychology and the NSS volunteers from that department were in charge of the events on the 6th day of The NSS Special camp. The NSS volunteers had made posters on topics pertinent to the lives of the students like the importance of team work over individual work, how to make friends, how to be mentally and physically healthy, the importance of health and hygiene, female sanitation awareness etc. The students themselves explained the topics using the posters they had made and through various games and activities. Both the students and NSS volunteers participated enthusiastically in the exercise. The second half of the camp was conducted by Ms, Satamita Samaddar, teacher from PIDILITE and alumnus of the college. She taught students how to make Tie and Dye print designs on fabric using Fevicryl paints and paint brushes. These implements were provided by the college for the students. By using fabric paints and folding cotton garments in various ways, fabulous colourful designs could be made easily. This was done to spark creativity in children and give them alternatives to spend their leisure time in productive ways. The students were delighted when their fabrics became colorful with different designs. They displayed them proudly to their teachers and asked the volunteers to come back soon with more such activities.
